9. Easements and deeds.
10. Fort Bend County Levee Improvement District No. 19 proposal for construction of Lost Creek Pump Station.
11. Engineering matters, including:
 - a. station numbers for District facilities;
 - b. First Colony MUD 9 maintenance of Ditch "B" outfall;
 - c. Closure of Flat Bank Creek diversion channel;
 - d. authorize design, approve plans and specifications, authorize advertisement, and award contract for construction and maintenance projects in the district, including:
 - i. outfall ditch slope paving and interior pond expansions;
 - e. pay estimates and change orders for construction and maintenance projects in the district.
12. Fort Bend Flood Management Association ("FBFMA") meetings and updates, proposed brochures, NFIP legislation, and flood management conferences and updates and approve all reimbursements to directors.
13. Emergency action planning.
